Ignite Studios @ NRCG is an extension of the Northern Rivers Community Gallery (NRCG), a community-engaged cultural hub in the Northern Rivers region, owned and operated by Ballina Shire Council.

Located in the heart of the Ballina CBD, adjacent to the NRCG and housed in the historic former Ballina Fire Station, Ignite Studios provides a dynamic shared access space supporting the development and participation of creative pursuits. Facilities include three subsidised creative spaces, a visiting artist-in-residence (AiR) studio and two access spaces for workshops, creative events, pop-up exhibitions, meetings and special projects.

The three creative spaces pertaining to this application are designated as Studios #1, #2 and #4. These spaces utilise the original residential living areas and range in size from 10m2 to 18m2. The studio spaces are available for a six or twelve month lease to creative practitioners from all disciplines. Practitioners from Ballina Shire, Northern Rivers and across NSW are welcome to apply.

Applications are open to:

- Creative practitioners from all disciplines, including but not limited to design, visual arts, digital media, photography, performance, film, music and writers.
- Small independant creative industry including but not limited to design, archtitechture, film, music, arts administrators, curators etc
- Creative practitioners from all career-stages
- Applicants must be 18 years of age or above

ABOUT THE SPACES

The subsidised creative spaces at *Ignite Studios* @ *NRCG* are designed to encourage co-working and an open platform for professional development and opportunity. Providing greater access to shared creative space in the Northern Rivers region, Ignite Studios aims to support and nurture innovative arts and creative industry through:

- provision of subsidised workspaces
- enabling creative projects and/or creative start-ups
- networking artists with arts influencers, local communities and peers through NRCG annual program
- building a hub for creative industry and ideas

INCLUSIONS

- Empty space with basic lighting/power outlets and picture rails
- All outgoings incl. electricity/water*
- Outdoor cold water wash basin area
- Private lockable studio spaces
- 24 hour access
- Air conditioning (studios 1 and 4 only)
- Bathroom facilities

- Wireless internet access (when available)
- Cross promotion in NRCG online marketing (when applicable)
- Wheelchair accessible
- Professional development and networking opportunities through the annual NRCG program and other special events.
- Ability to sell products through NRCG Shop (subject to a 33% consignment commission)
- Standard Waste Collection and grounds maintenance
- Initial 12 month lease period with possibility to renew
- Rent beginning from \$70 (incl. gst) per week
- Ample street parking

* exception for high power consumption equipment such as kilns. Usage would be metered and charged at an additional cost based on monthly usage.

Conditional Inclusions

- A kitchenette (Note: only available if the residential AiR space is not in use).
- Wireless internet is installed for Gallery programs and studio tenants can utilise free of charge when available. (Note: this is a courtesy and not included in the lease agreement)
- Renters can utilise additional spaces, 'The Engine Room' and 'The Locker Room' to run workshops or special projects for an additional fee. (Note: standard workshop space hire fees are applicable)

FEES

Studio space rental is paid monthly in advance and a Direct Debit from a nominated bank account will be required to be set-up at time of signing the agreement. A security deposit equivalent to 4 weeks rent will be required.

Studio renters can access 'The Locker Room' and 'The Engine Room' for an additional fee (standard workshop space hire fees) when available.

STUDIO AGREEMENT

Studio tenants will be issued with a Studio Agreement governing all aspects of their access to the Ignite Studio facilities. Due to the heritage of the building, access and use will be in accordance with certain prescribed conditions for example drilling into, modifying or fixing on to the walls is prohibited. In addition to these conditions, the general terms of the agreement will include the following.

- The Renter will indemnify and keep indemnified Ballina Shire Council (and NRCG), its officers, agents and contractors against all liability for death or injury to persons or loss of or damage to property (including property of BSC and NRCG) and all actions, claims, demands, losses, damages, costs and expenses which may be suffered or sustained pursuant to their Studio Rental Agreement.
- This indemnity will also apply to any persons and property that is on site at Ignite Studios or NRCG as a consequence of the actions of the Renter either pursuant to or in breach of the conditions of their Studio Agreement.
- Renters are required to have their own Public Liability insurance with cover to the value of \$20 million.
- The Renter agrees to comply with all necessary workplace health and safety laws and regulations.
- Access is available 24/7. Standard residential noise restrictions apply after 10pm seven days a week.
- The studio spaces are not open to the general public except for open days or special events specified and organised by NRCG.
- Renters are responsible for ensuring the premises are fully secure on leaving the facility, managing waste collection and for keeping their studio clean and tidy at all times.
- Renters are to work within their nominated studio unless an alternative arrangement has been made with NRCG management.
- Studios cannot be utilized for industrial or semi-industrial creative processes, retail sales outlet, public events, unlicensed alcohol sales.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Allocation of studios will be made balancing a mix of art forms, career stage and studio experience within the facility, in order to encourage diversity and a vibrant creative hub encouraging dialogue, exchange and innovation. Key selection criteria will be based on:

- Quality of work or projects and originality of ideas.
- Value of a studio to the development of the practitioner.
- Suitability of creative activity for a studio space.
- Commitment of time to using the studio.

HOW TO APPLY

Complete an application form with required support material.

Support Material

- 1. 3 good quality images of recent works and/or Weblink to website, portfolio, or showreel etc. (please include image titles/descriptions if applicable)
- 2. One A4 page CV
- 3. Response to the following 'creative practice' questions and attach to your application form:
 - Please describe your creative activity, outlining materials and processes and/or the concepts informing your practice. (150 word limit)
 - B. Describe how access to a studio would benefit your practice.
 (150 word limit)
 - C. Studio tentants will be asked to participate in the Ignite Studio community or NRCG annual program up to 2 times per year. This may include artist talks, master classes, mentoring, school engagement programs, performances, readings and other activities organized by NRCG. Please describe how you could contribute. (50 word limit)

Please note:

ALL attachments (response to questions and support material) must be provided in one pdf attachment if applying via email (total size limit 10MB) and on a USB flashdrive for hardcopy applications.

If you do not provide the necessary material your application may not be assessed. Excess support material will not be considered.

DO NOT send original artwork with your application as forms and attachments will NOT be returned
